They do not let outer circumstances dictate whether or not they will keep their hearts open. And daily we will find greater strength of heart as we are willing to take love's hand and let its gentle guidance illuminate our path. Never stop loving. It is our only salvation and our only hope of finding true peace."

I've heard it said that, "Life is too short for drama and petty things, so laugh hard, love truly and forgive quickly. Tell the people you love that you love them, at every opportunity."

Honoring Fr. Ray Introvigne




